By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$2,000 to enter and start with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$124,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of Grade I or II stakes on the turf since October 4, allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 twice on the turf since August 1, 5 lbs.; \$45,000 twice on the turf since July 4, 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, March 31, 2004 with 29 nominations. Footnotes

PERFECT SOUL (IRE), reserved between rivals four wide from early on, was asked for his best leaving the five-sixteenths pole, maneuvered out six wide when straightened for the drive, then was hard ridden to prevail in course record time. BURNING ROMA, well placed from the outset while lightly rated three or four wide, moved between rivals entering the stretch, loomed boldly through the drive, then was outfinished when bumped for several strides about 50 yards from the finish by ROYAL SPY and carried out a bit by that one. ROYAL SPY moved to the fore inside, went along under careful handling, made the pace into deep stretch and couldn't last while coming out approaching the wire and bumping with BURNING ROMA. HONOR IN WAR followed the leaders five or six wide from early on, moved outside the winner to be eight wide when straightened for the drive and offered a mild gain. STROLL angled in behind the leaders early, saved ground most of the way, raced prominently near the rail into the final furlong and flattened out when the test came. MILLENNIUM DRAGON (GB) settled two wide, raced within easy striking distance, eased out between rivals four or five wide for the drive but couldn't muster the needed response. FREEFOURINTERNET, badly outrun to the stretch, was near the inside for the drive and improved position while not a threat. PERFECT DRIFT, within easy striking distance while following the leaders four or five wide, eased out between foes six or seven wide in the upper stretch and never menaced. NEEDWOOD BLADE (GB) was outrun. HEAR NO EVIL bobbed sharply soon after the start, was hustled along soon after to go after front-running ROYAL SPY five wide, held on well until nearing the final quarter and steadily weakened.
