Footnotes

LILACS AND LACE set the pace along the inside, opened clear after a half, widened into the stretch and stayed on well to hold a diminishing advantage. WYOMIA was well placed between rivals, split horses to make her bid entering the stretch, had the rider lose the inside iron a furlong out, but kept on with good courage and was making up ground late. KATHMANBLU settled under a snug hold four wide, came five wide to make her bid, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. BOUQUET BOOTH was forwardly placed along the inside, got through entering the stretch, but went evenly through the drive. GRAND STYLE bobbled at the start, tucked in to save ground, finished with a mild rally but failed to threaten. DRAW IT was unhurried into stride, swung seven wide and passed the tiring ones. DELIGHTFUL MARY pressed the pace three wide, but faltered between horses leaving the second turn and retreated. EXCITED attended the pace four wide for six furlongs and dropped out. DANCINGINHERDREAMS was rank to place between horses four wide, drifted out further on the second turn and was never a factor.
