Footnotes

MASTER O FOXHOUNDS vied for the lead off the inside, took over on the turn and slowly increased his lead under steady urging. GO WEST, forwardly placed inside, was angled out a bit once on the turn, moved closest to the winner after a half but lacked a further bid. UNLOOSENED, outrun early off the inside, settled in upper stretch and closed well. SMOKE SIGNAL, outrun early off the inside, found his best stride too late. ROLL AGAIN, forwardly placed out in the strip, raced three wide on the turn and tired in the drive. ONTOU, unhurried early three wide, was no threat. VALID BELFAST, unhurried early, raced three wide late on the turn and was no factor. PART THE WATERS, reserved early off the inside, was angled out a bit for the drive but could not menace. POLISHED BRASS alternated for the lead inside, stayed well to the stretch and faded. ALBADAR was no factor.
