Footnotes

TENPINS, ridden a bit after the start to gain the lead, maneuvered in to race two or three wide, went along under careful handling, was headed briefly in the upper stretch from the outside by DEFERRED COMP, dug in tenaciously to regain the advantage and outgamed that one in the closing yards. DEFERRED COMP, lightly rated early while tracking TENPINS three wide, inched after that one approaching the stretch, poked his head in front just prior to the eighth pole, then wasn't quite good enough while superior to the rest. IT'S SO SIMPLE, within easy striking distance while three or four wide to the end of the backstretch, ended in around the turn but was empty in the drive. LAKE SILVER, checked in a bit tight around the first turn, eased off the inside entering the backstretch but weakened upon going six furlongs. JON'S PROSPECT, within striking distance while near the inside for six furlongs, weakened thereafter.
