SONG TRACK reserved off the inside, advanced in the two path after a half, moved between rivals with three furlongs to go, waited briefly for QUICK TEMPER to move past approaching the stretch, angled three wide leaving the second turn, challenged with a furlong to go and drew off under steady urging. QUICK TEMPER within striking distance three wide, advanced four wide into the second turn, challenged soon after, stayed on well to the stretch, was no match for the winner but held on for the place. TANGO FOR TIPS vied for the lead off the inside and tired in the final furlong. JINNY'S GOLD close up along the inside, steadied entering the backstretch when boxed in, recovered, held on well to the stretch and gave way. SISTER STAR reserved early, improved her position while no threat. ROUSED outrun early along the inside, was no threat. RENAISSANCE LADY within striking distance off the inside, moved out to be five wide for the second turn and faded. GO GRACE GO alternated for the lead along the inside and faded. FIFTH OVERTURE prompted the pace in the three path and stopped. WESTERN HUSSY broke in the air, drifted wide on the first turn, stopped and was outdistanced.
