STAKES Maker's Mark Mile S. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$15,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$186,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$9,000 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of Grade I stakes on the turf since October 3, allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade I or II at a mile or over on the turf since October 3, 4 lbs.; a graded stakes at a mile or over in 2008-2009, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Wednesday, April 1, 2009 with 19 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

MR. SIDNEY settled into stride removed from the inside, took closer order down the backstretch and through the second turn, forged command and opened clear entering the stretch, turned back the bid of PASSAGER (FR) inside the furlong marker and gamely held sway. PASSAGER (FR) was reserved off of the pace and settled near the back of the pack, advanced four wide for a striking position, launched a bold bid entering the lane, drew to the throat latch of MR. SIDNEY with a furlong to run but was held at bay through the drive. JUST AS WELL was unhurried into stride, came five wide to make a late rally and was along for the show. HOUSE OF SILVER attended the pace toward the inside, got through to make a mild bid but weakened during the drive. FLUKE (BRZ) disputed the pace along the inside, settled off of the lead entering the backstretch, shifted off of the rail and re-engaged with three furlongs to run, but came up empty entering the lane and faded. THORN SONG lunged at the start and was away a bit slow, recovered quickly and rushed to contention three wide, opened clear and angled in before going three furlongs, but faltered suddenly entering the second turn and dropped out.
