Footnotes

ALL COUNTY stalked the dueling leaders along the inside, got through entering the stretch, shifted out inside the furlong marker, reeled in the leaders and was inching away. GIBSON CRYSTAL disputed the pace on even terms with VALID SUPREME to inside the eighth pole, kept on well through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. VALID SUPREME pulled to the lead along the inside, dueled for supremacy to the final furlong, but weakened following a long drive and grudgingly gave way. DEVIL'S LIL BIT broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride toward the inside, angled out leaving the turn and was making up ground late. CREDIT CRUNCH was unhurried into stride, made a mild rally circling six wide but failed to threaten. SHE'S THE UMPIRE attended the pace three wide between horses, but lacked a response when called upon. ALICE'S SMART made a middle move five wide, offered a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive.
