Footnotes

WAR DANCER rank breaking when unprepared at the start, was outrun for five furlongs, advanced 4 wide thereafter and closed fast to be up in time. POSITIVELY reserved off the rail, made a run four wide leaving the second turn and closed well but missed. TENFORTHEMONEY within striking distance, saved ground on the second turn, angled out once in the stretch and rallied willingly late. BOLD CHALLENGER set the pace near the rail, repulsed a bid by FIVE IRON entering the stretch, drew clear but was outfinished. BEYOND COMPARE close up along the inside, stayed on well to the stretch, challenged with a furlong to go but weakened. FIVE IRON came in early, raced closest to the pace off the inside, challenged on the second turn but tired in the drive. JUMP FOR KITTEN came in early tightening up inner rivals, raced close up while off the rail, held on well to the final quarter and tired. MY FRIEND JIMMY outrun early, raced four wide with a quarter mile to go and could not threaten. YORKSHIRE ICON (GB) within striking distance inside, moved off the rail for the second turn and faded. FREDERICKSBURG steadied and shuffled back at the start, recovered to race within reach but faded. NIIGON'S GLORY steadied and shuffled back at the start, failed to menace. COLLIN'S SMILE steadied and squeezed back at the start, was no factor.
