LIBERTY GOLD, never far back and saving ground early, moved four wide on the turn to edge closer, wrested command in the upper stretch and increased his advantage under solid hand urging. DEPUTY DIAMOND, well placed inside from early on, came out to advance from between foes nearing the stretch, loomed prominently in the drive but wasn't a match for the winner. BURKHARDT broke through the gate prior to the start and was alertly snared by the assistant starter. During the running, BURKHARDT was outrun early, made a bid five wide entering the stretch but could gain only slightly late. FLASHING TAMMANY, away well to stalked the pace four wide, flattened out when the test came. PHONE THE KING failed to menace. SUPER MARFALOUS sprinted clear soon after the start, made the pace until the stretch and gave way readily.
