ZINFANDOLL, taken in hand soon after the start while confidently ridden, followed the leaders four wide around the second turn and into the stretch, then wore down UANME in the final stages. UANME stalked the dueling leaders from early on while three abreast, gained a narrow edge in the upper stretch, then couldn't contain the winner late. SHORT TIME, outrun early and unhurried for six furlongs, swung out from behind a wall of horses six wide leaving the eighth pole and offered a mild gain. HEAVENLEY LARK went up early to vie for the lead outside of MAID BY THE FIRE, alternated for the lead with that one to the stretch and weakened the final furlong. BARN SWALLOW saved ground but failed to rally. COURTINGAPRINCESS wasn't a factor. IF ANGELS SANG raced within easy striking distance into the final furlong and faltered. MAID BY THE FIRE was used up dueling for the lead the opening three-quarters.
