Footnotes

CAMARA CAT gained the lead near the inside early, edged clear around the turn, made the balance of the pace and was hard ridden to last. MAY GATOR, outrun from the start, saved ground into the stretch, came out five or six wide, swerved back to the inside leaving the eighth pole to avoid congestion, jolted with RACING RUBY when that one leaned in approaching the finish and earned second. GOODNESS, never far back while following the winner three or four wide, loomed a solid threat through the drive from between rivals and wasn't good enough. SIXTYONE MARGAUX, a bit sluggish to begin, reached contention on the turn near the inside and slowly was gaining from the rail in the late stages. WILDCAT VICTORY, bumped at the start by SPANISH HOUND and outrun for a half, made a run five or six wide concluding the turn, was steadied hard leaving the eighth pole when RACING RUBY was forced out in front of her, then lacked a final response. RACING RUBY, never far back, was put to a drive at the five-sixteenths pole, moved five wide into the lane, was bumped by STORM DANCER and forced out at the eighth pole in front of WILDCAT VICTORY, then leaned in late bumping soundly with MAY GATOR while weakening. STORM DANCER pressed the winner from early on while three or four wide, came out under left-handed pressure bumping RACING RUBY forcing that one out at the eighth pole, then faded. STORMY PORT bobbed a bit at the start and tired early. I BELONG never was close. SPANISH HOUND came out at the break bumping WILDCAT VICTORY, edged in to track the leaders early while three or four wide, held on well for a half and gradually weakened
