CLEAR DESTINY broke in front, relaxed nicely while showing the way two or three wide under confident handling, turned back a mild challenge from CATALITA entering the far turn, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and prevailed under mild hand encouragement. SANTA ROSA ISLAND, settled inside, was outrun to the far turn, continued to save ground while making a run into the stretch, couldn't threaten the winner but outgamed CATALITA for second. CATALITA, close up three abreast early, angled in behind the winner on the first turn, eased out four wide on the backstretch, offered a challenge on the far turn but flattened out when straightened into the stretch. MADAME THOR, a bit sluggish to begin, moved up quickly between foes, was four or five wide in a contending position to the end of the backstretch and tired.
