CROW JANE vied for the lead early while between foes three or four wide, edged inward when able, battled with WE'LLSEE GOLD until the final quarter, drew off quickly when asked, then was kept to her task. HALORY LEIGH, sluggish to begin and outrun near the inside to the stretch, worked her way out five or six wide leaving the turn and finished well as clearly second best. DANCE HALL GIRL tracked the leaders in a contending position four or five wide from early on, moved in closest attendance to the winner while outside that one approaching the final furlong but was unable to muster a late threat. D' NILE, also within striking distance five wide much of the way, flattened out the last eighth. WE'LLSEE GOLD contested the pace from early on while dueling outside the winner, raced forwardly to the stretch and weakened. MOLTO VITA, well placed but hung out six wide to the stretch, flattened out when straightened for the drive. BABY LETS CRUISE, outsprinted for a half while near the inside, eased out five or six wide for the drive but failed to respond. HURRY HOME, outrun to the stretch while in behind horses, moved well off the inside for the drive and never reached contention. GAMBLE TO VICTORY, forwardly placed inside for a half, weakened thereafter. YOREN was outrun. CHINESE TEA never was prominent.
