**Footnotes**

ROYAL SPY went up soon after the break to press front-running ANGEL ON THE WING under light rating, raced three or four wide, took over from that one just prior to going a half while within himself, opened a clear lead when called upon in the upper stretch, then held sway under energetic handling. MIESQUE'S APPROVAL, bumped at the start but never far back, was six wide on the backstretch under light restraint, edged in a bit while advancing on the second turn, loomed prominently outside the winner through the drive but wasn't good enough. TOUCH OF THE BLUES (FR) gained a forward position early while maneuvering in between foes, began to edge closer leaving the backstretch, moved menacingly between horses into the upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. MISTER ACPEN (CHI), unhurried for a half while in hand four or five wide, continued in that position on the course approaching the stretch, then offered a mild gain. STATEMENT settled between foes early while three or four wide, continued behind rivals around the far turn and into the stretch and improved position while unable to menace four wide. DECARCHY, in contention from the outset and five or six wide to the stretch, moved out farther on the course for the drive but failed to respond. PRIVATE SON, nicely placed near the inside from early on, worked his way out four or five wide when entering the stretch but flattened out the last eighth. POLITICAL ATTACK stumbled at the start and came out bumping MIESQUE'S APPROVAL, was unhurried inside, saved ground for six furlongs, swung out eight wide for the drive but failed to respond. ANGEL ON THE WING gained the lead inside early, showed the way for a half, surrendered the advantage to the winner, continued forwardly to the stretch and faded.
