Footnotes

IMPRESSIVE LOOK, reserved early two wide, was patiently handled, circled foes with a deft move nine wide into the upper stretch and closed with a flourish to be along in time. SI SI MON AMIE went up to press front-running QUEEN OF THE RIDGE early, reached the front between calls in deep stretch, then was outfinished. DRESS UNIFORM, unhurried early and four wide, moved seven wide when straightened into the stretch and was going well at the end. QUEEN OF THE RIDGE gained the advantage near the inside early, made the pace into deep stretch and weakened. SOUSAPHONE, never far back and between horses three wide, was empty in the late going and dead heated with STORMY WEST for fifth. STORMY WEST, in hand while following the leaders four or five wide, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but flattened out to finish evenly with STORMY WEST. SPRUNG, unhurried early, raced two wide, swung out five wide for the drive and had no rally. DANCER'S FAN, well positioned inside to the stretch, couldn't offer a further account. CHERSKY leaned in bumping the side of the gate at the start, went up soon after to track the pace three abreast and weakened leaving the second turn.
