STAKES Vinery Madison S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$10,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 start, with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$124,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes since October 6 allowed 2 lbs.; \$60,000 in 2007, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 twice 2006-2007, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Vinery Madison will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies or mares pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2006-2007 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, March 28, with 33 nominations.

MARY DELANEY came out bumping lightly with GINGER PUNCH at the break, gained the lead, drew clear and raced well off the inside to the end of the backstretch, edged in two wide, came out again to be four or five wide for the drive and was kept to her task to hold sway. GINGER PUNCH, bumped lightly at the start by the winner, raced in behind horses, was put to a drive three furlongs out, advanced five or six wide into the lane, dropped inside the winner very late and bested LEAH'S SECRET for the place. LEAH'S SECRET, outrun to the stretch, commenced a sweeping run seven wide into the lane and was going well at the end. BRIGHT ABUNDANCE, outrun while in behind rivals to the lane, rallied from the rail, made a solid run into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the move. MODJADJI raced forwardly near the inside to the upper stretch and couldn't keep pace. MORETHANAPRINCESS tracked the winner four wide into the final furlong and weakened. MISS NORMAN, five wide, had no rally in an even effort. YOLANDA B. TOO raced within striking distance while in behind foes to the lane, angled out a bit and failed to fire. HOT STORM chased the winner until nearing the final quarter and tired. ATLAS VALLEY was outrun.
