STAKES Shakertown S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed, of which \$62,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weights: Three year olds, 117 lbs.; older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes in 2009 or \$300,000 since October 3, allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 since October 3, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Shakertown will be limited to twelve if on the Haggin Course or ten with two also eligibles if on the Keeneland Course. In the event that more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2008-2009. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 1, 2009 with 31 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Six Furlongs on the main track.

Footnotes

HEROS REWARD five wide into the turn when within striking distance, responded when set down in the stretch and wore down the leaders late. CANNONBALL behind the leaders, stayed out four wide into the turn, moved closer approaching the stretch and rallied willingly late. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE closest to the pace four wide, challenged on the turn and held on gamely but was outfinished. DUE DATE outrun early, commenced his his three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and closed well. MR. NIGHTLINGER sprinted clear, set the pace near the rail, responded willingly when challenged on the turn, held on well to inside the final furlong and weakened. HEWITTS forwardly placed, was in tight entering the turn, recovered but lacked a closing bid. CROWNED GENERAL six wide into the turn when outsprinted, was no threat. TENKILLER LAKE close up between rivals, was in tight entering the turn and tired. INCRIMINATE outrun off the inside, was no factor. GODOLPHIN GRAY seven wide into the turn, could not menace.

HELLVELYN (GB) never far back, took up entering the turn then stopped.
