HERE COMES BEN inherited the lead before going a quarter, set a slow pace along the inside, turned back the bid of SPEIGHT THE HALO and MAJESTIC BLUE after a half, settled into the stretch clear, and drew away despite taking a few awkward strides to avoid sun breaks in the shadow of the rail at the sixteenth pole and again near the wire. CALIMONCO was taken in hand at once, settled at the tail of the field, swung five wide to make a late rally and was along in time to earn the place. SPEIGHT THE HALO broke sharply, was reserved off of the pace under tight restraint, came three wide to engage HERE COMES BEN with three furlongs to run, proved no match for that one, but stayed on fairly well and just failed to hold the second spot. MAJESTIC BLUE tracked the pace in hand, moved up to make a mild bid four wide but lacked the needed late response. SLICK PARDONED ME broke through the gate prior to the start, settled along the inside but lacked a response when asked.
