SIR MCINTYRE attended the pace along the inside, shifted out between horses leaving the second turn, and wore down THUNDEROUS G under stern urging. THUNDEROUS G set the pace off of the inside, kept on well through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. SILVER DIB disputed the issue three wide, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. LEMANSKY was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, got through and finished with a belated gain. MR. TICKET was fractious in the gate, broke slow, settled between rivals, worked his way to the outside on the second turn, came six wide, but lacked a response when put to pressure. KARMA SHIELD bobbled at the start, settled in hand four wide while never far back, but came up empty after six furlongs and faded. NEVER CROSS contended five wide to the stretch and retreated.
