NOTORIETY settled in hand off of the inside, angled out five wide to make his bid, shook clear a furlong out and held sway. THE PADDYMAN (IRE) was allowed to settle, circled six wide into the stretch, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. FLASHY GREEN tracked the pace three wide, made his bid between horses, lacked the needed kick and settled for the minor award. RED ACE pulled to the fore to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SAINT WILL contended four wide but went evenly through the drive. DUKE OF DEL REY stalked the pace toward the inside, moved out to make his bid between horses but failed to sustain the drive. VOODOO DOCTOR was forwardly placed between horses to the stretch and faded. PRINCE SILVER was unhurried into stride, swung eight wide but came up empty in the drive. CASINO DAN pulled to contention off of the inside, angled in leaving the turn but came up empty after a half. SMARTER THAN EVER failed to respond. SEMINOLE ROAD was through early and distanced through the stretch.
