REFLECTING tracked the pace off of the inside, looped up four wide to commence a bold bid leaving the final turn, came to level terms with a furlong to run, shook off SNEAKY KITTEN and edged clear late. SNEAKY KITTEN attended the pace along the inside, got through and moved up to engage BELO ACTEON (BRZ) nearing the quarter pole, forged command and fought on through the drive but was unable to match strides through the final yards. BELO ACTEON (BRZ) opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the final turn, gave way and was all out to just hold the show. PARIS IS ART was close up three wide but lacked the needed late response. N. B. A. MONEY broke slow, was unhurried into stride, took closer order on the backstretch but failed to improved position further. SOUL OF THE MOON failed to respond. BOB'S GONE WILD was never a factor. I SMELL SMOKE settled in the second flight and showed little.
