Footnotes

CHEER FOR SLEW, never far back and saving ground from early on, angled outside pacesetting NOVEMBER SLEW leaving the eighth pole and, while drifting out slightly in the late stages, was along in time. NOVEMBER SLEW gained the lead soon after the start, raced in the three path, held a clear advantage at the furlong grounds but could not last. ROSES ROSES ROSES stalked the pace five wide from early on, loomed menacingly for the final furlong but came up empty. REGAL TALK drifted in at the start bumping DAY AFTER, was bumped soon after by COUNTESS DE TIEMPO, raced in a striking position but failed to rally. RARE BEAUTY, within easy striking distance, loomed four wide for the drive but flattened out when the test came. DAY AFTER bobbled sharply at the start and was bumped soon after by REGAL TALK, was outrun until the stretch and not a threat while improving position. ISABELLA ROSE failed to reach contention. HERA was finished when straightened for the drive and deadheaded for eighth with HEROISS. The latter passed tired ones to finish evenly with HERA. CLASSIC WOMAN was done after a half. COUNTESS DE TIEMPO drifted in soon after the start bumping REGAL TALK, then was never close. NATIVE ROOTS (IRE) gave way early.
