STAKES Jenny Wiley S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

For fillies and mares four years old and upward. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to enter. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of Grade I or II stakes on the turf since September 1 allowed 3 lbs.; \$60,000 twice on the turf since August 1, 5 lbs.; \$45,000 twice on the turf since July 1, 7 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Jenny Wiley will be limited to ten. In the event that more than ten fillies or mares pass the entry box, the ten starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2000-2001. Same owner entry cannot start to the exclusion of a single entry. Closed March 28, 2001 with 39 nominations. HAGGIN COURSE.

Footnotes

PENNY'S GOLD settled inside, saved ground while edging up nearing the stretch, came around fading SURPRISE AGENDA placing LADY OF PEACE in tight quarters, moved back inside when able, angled outside front-running LICENSE FEE for the final furlong and drove clear late under mild encouragement. LICENSE FEE drifted out at the start bumping LADY OF PEACE, went up soon after to press front-running SURPRISE AGENDA, took over early on the second turn, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage but wasn't a match for PENNY'S GOLD in the late stages. SOLVIG, outrun early, reached contention as the field bunched nearing the end of the backstretch, commenced a sweeping six wide run approaching the stretch, loomed a strong threat for the final furlong but failed to respond. GOOD GAME raced forwardly while three wide most of the way but was empty when the test came. APPLE OF KENT tracked the leaders three or four wide from early on, was asked for her best at the five-sixteenths and flattened out when straightened for the drive. LADY OF PEACE, bumped at the start, bobbled soon after when nearly clipping the heels of LICENSE FEE, settled inside, was blocked behind a wall of horses about the five-sixteenths pole, bobbled sharply when placed in tight by the winner, lightly clipped the heels of HISTOIRE SAINTE (FR) and was finished. INSIDE AFFAIR followed the leaders in a contending position five wide to the far turn and couldn't keep pace. HISTOIRE SAINTE (FR), in hand while stalking the leaders four wide, weakened on the second turn and had her heels lightly clipped at the five-sixteenths by LADY OF PEACE. SURPRISE AGENDA rushed to the front early, made the pace until the end of the backstretch and faded thereafter.
