Footnotes

SEATTLE BAY, rated in behind the leaders four wide from early on, angled out a bit farther on the course while advancing into the stretch, then was hard ridden to prevail. TOBARANAMA (IRE), well placed in behind rivals early, was with the winner on the second turn, had to await room in the upper stretch, split foes a furlong out three wide and finished with good courage. BURNHAM, bumped at the start, went up to gain the lead three wide, fell back on the second turn, dug in to gain even terms for the lead nearing the furlong grounds, but wasn't good enough. SHOPPINGWITHBETTY, unhurried early, swung out seven wide into the stretch to loom a decent threat but failed to sustain the needed momentum. PEANUT GALLERY drifted out at the start bumping BURNHAM, was outrun for six furlongs, ranged up between foes five wide in deep stretch but lacked the needed response. FLINCH (GB) unseated the rider in the post parade and again while warming up. During the running, FLINCH (GB) followed the leaders five or six wide throughout and failed to rally. SILKS FOR DI, a bit rank during the opening half, moved up to force the pace from the outside, raced five or six wide while taking over on the second turn, held on well into the stretch and faltered. VACUNA bobbed at the start and was bumped, trailed for six furlongs, swung out eight or nine wide for the stretch run and failed to respond. SWEETEST SECRET drifted out at the start bumping VACUNA, went up soon after to force the pace three or four wide, held on well for six furlongs and tired. NORTHERN KENTUCKY saved ground but tired early.
