SERRA RETREAT gained the lead near the inside early, went along under careful handling, turned back a challenge from CANADIAN PESO approaching the stretch and was under steady encouragement the remainder. CANADIAN PESO maneuvered in early to track the winner four wide, raced in closest attendance to SERRA RETREAT throughout, challenged earnestly nearing the stretch but wasn't good enough. CRIMSON HERO, outrun inside for a half, eased out a bit on the far turn, raced five wide into the stretch but could gain only slightly in the drive. VALIANT KING, well placed while racing in behind the winner to the far turn, moved out a bit, continued within easy striking distance to the stretch and came up empty. SEA DUB settled inside, advanced along the rail on the far turn, moved four or five wide into the upper stretch but failed to gain. IT'S TRIPLE GEORGE bobbed at the start while breaking slowly to the outside, then failed to seriously threaten. IMPERIAL THEATRE (IRE) tired on the far turn. AMHERST WILDCAT was outrun. GOLD CITY SLEW angled in early to track the pace four or five wide and tired entering the far turn. SPEARSMILL tired early.
