Footnotes

DEED IT IS was unhurried into stride along the inside, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, split horses entering the stretch, came four wide, drew even a furlong out, brushed with A. P. ELI in the drive and wore down that one late. A. P. ELI disputed the pace along the inside, fought on through a long drive, brushed with the winner a sixteenth out and gave in. DOVER BEACH was unhurried into stride, advanced between horses, angled out entering the stretch and kept on well to earn the show. SURF CAST contested the pace three wide to the stretch and gave way. NACONA was allowed to settle, came five wide and finished with a belated gain. STREET TALK'N MAN was hustled along four wide for six furlongs and faded. MR TRIBUTE broke slow and was bumped, rushed to contention between horses, but came up empty on the second turn and retreated. MULL OVER chased three wide through the second turn and tired. MONGOL BOY saved ground to little avail. SIGNATURE EVENT settled in hand four wide, but was through after a half and dropped out.
