**Footnotes**

A GIRL NEEDS CASH gained the lead inside at the start, shook off challenge from UNBRIDLED VICE midway of the turn, edged clear into the stretch and increased her advantage when ridden out. WOLFNİK leaned in at the start and bumped with REGENT GOLD, was outrun while saving ground, rallied from the rail and bested the others while no threat to the winner. REGENT GOLD, bumped at the start, settled inside, saved ground until the stretch, angled four wide for the drive but lacked a closing response. SUN BRUSHED, well placed until the stretch, weakened in the drive. UNBRIDLED VICE went up early to press the winner from the outside, challenged earnestly on the turn but weakened in the drive. DE BERTIE ducked out at the start jolting SKY AWAY, was outrun until the stretch and not a threat while improving position. OATSEE made a mild bid to reach contention concluding the turn but flattened out in the drive. NATURALLY WILD was finished leaving the turn. DECADENT DESIGNER bore in badly at the start and slammed SKY AWAY, then wasn't a factor. BOURBON MINT stalked the leaders in a forward position for a half and tired. SKY AWAY was eliminated soon after at the start when slammed from both sides and taken wide soon after. DANZING DANETTE was done early.
