GOLD STREAMER gained the lead inside early, edged clear, went along under careful handling, turned back a bid from her stablemate, ROYAL FAIR entering the stretch, then moved clear late under intermittent urging. ROYAL FAIR, unhurried early, made a bold run four wide approaching the stretch, was just off GOLD STREAMER but not good enough in the final stages. EXPLOSIVE GAL moved inside early, made a run from the rail entering the stretch but lacked a late response. PRINCIPAL AFFAIR stalked the winner from early on, held on well for six furlongs and weakened. DRIVE THRU BLUES followed the leaders in a striking position four wide until the stretch and tired. CRAFTY CHARACTER, five or six wide most of the way, failed to respond. MIMI'S GOLDEN GIRL faded approaching the stretch.
