**Footnotes**

ALTERNATE gained the lead near the inside early, raced in hand, accelerated when called upon entering the stretch to quickly move clear, then, despite shying and jumping a shadow on the track in the final sixteenth, won going away. UNSURPASSED, rated off the pace early while four or five wide, continued in that position on the track to advance approaching the stretch, was just off the winner for the drive but couldn't menace as second best. TOMOKAS OUTRAGEOUS, always well placed while racing in behind the winner, was empty in the drive. SARATOGA CAT, outrun until approaching the stretch, rallied between foes a quarter-mile out, swung out six or seven wide for the drive, improved position but couldn't threaten. AS TOLD, six or seven wide into the backstretch, edged in around the far turn, continued inside into the stretch but was empty. BEE MY HONEY, forwardly placed between foes to the end of the backstretch, weakened thereafter. CUNNING PLAY broke slowly and awkwardly, was steadied repeatedly around the first turn and into the backstretch, raced five wide, made a mild run on the second turn but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SIXTH AND WALNUT was outrun. RAISE A ROAR stalked the leaders four or five wide for six furlongs and faded. FULL SPECTRUM never reached contention.
