STAKES Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

For three year olds and upward. (Includes \$100,000 from Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup Nominees only). By subscription of \$250 each, which should accompany the nomination, \$2,500 to enter and start with \$150,000 added and an additional \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup eligibles only. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weights: Three year olds, 116 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since October 25 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II since September 1, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 twice since July 4, 6 lbs. Closed April 2, 2003 with 25 nominations.

SMOOTH JAZZ moved to the fore near the inside soon after the start, went along under careful handling, then expanded his advantage late under mild encouragement. CRAFTY C. T., never far back, worked his way in behind the leaders approaching the end of the backstretch, saved ground to the stretch, came out three wide for the drive, loomed just off the winner but couldn't offer a challenge as second best. MULTIPLE CHOICE attended the pace early while between rivals, continued in closest attendance to SMOOTH JAZZ while outside that one to the stretch and weakened. BINTHEBEST, outrun to the stretch while near the inside, came out five wide for the drive, made a mild bid to reach contention at the furlong grounds but lacked a further account. SPEED HUNTER, five or six wide, wasn't a factor. ROMAN DANCER broke open the doors of his starting stall prior to the start but was in the hands of the assistant starter and couldn't escape. During the running, ROMAN DANCER leaned in at the break and bumped NAJRAN, raced close up early while five wide, fell back concluding the backstretch and weakened gradually. NAJRAN also popped the doors of the gate open prior to the start and immediately was grabbed by the assistant starter. During the running, NAJRAN broke in the air, was bumped by ROMAN DANCER, went up soon after to force the pace three abreast and tired upon going a half.
