Footnotes

MADCAP ESCAPADE broke a bit awkwardly to the inside and bumped the side of the gate, quickly recovered to track front-running REVOLUTIONARY ACT, moved to the fore when ready entering the turn and drew clear, then maintained her advantage under hand urging. MY TRUSTY CAT came out bumping with BENDING STRINGS at the start, was never far back, raced in behind horses, came out four or five wide for the drive and was fully extended to earn the place while unable to menace the winner. MOLTO VITA leaned in at the start bumping BENDING STRINGS, raced in the two path in a challenging position, came out four wide for the drive, was just off the winner for the last eighth and came up empty. SOURIS, outrun inside to the stretch, remained near the inside for the drive, made a mild run at the furlong grounds but failed to sustain the needed momentum. JOSH'S MADELYN, outrun for a half, maneuvered five wide entering the stretch but failed to gain in the final furlong. BENDING STRINGS, bumped from both sides at the start, raced in contention off the inside for a half and tired thereafter. REVOLUTIONARY ACT, in front after the start and clear for a quarter while maneuvering inside, lost the advantage to the winner entering the turn and faded.
