**Footnotes**

PANTY RAID stalked the dawdling pace from early on while in hand four or five wide, was never far back and closed determinedly to be along in time. SILENCE DOGOOD, in hand and two or three wide from the beginning, took over in the upper stretch, then yielded to the winner very late. BEES went up early to press front-running SPANISH GHOST, battled on even terms four wide into the stretch and wasn't quite good enough. QUIET JUNGLE, off a bit slow and angled in three wide at once, circled foes nine wide into the lane and was going well at the finish. A. P. DREAM, in a striking position between foes four wide, flattened out when the test came. PERFECT MOTION, unhurried early and four or five wide, failed to muster a closing punch. FULL OF IDEAS, never far back and four or five wide, was empty in the late going. SPANISH GHOST gained the advantage two or three wide, held on well until the stretch and tired. BROADBRUSH BEAUTY was done early on the far turn. UNTO THE HILLS tired after a half. AWSUGAHNOW faded approaching the stretch.
