**Footnotes**

MISS LOMBARDI chased front-running RADIANT AVIE from early on while three or four wide in hand, was asked for more about the five-sixteenths pole and outgamed I'M IN LOVE in a stiff drive. I'M IN LOVE, unhurried early, inched forward on the far turn, rallied five wide, battled with the winner while outside that one through the last eighth and couldn't get up. MOON BERRY (BRZ) gained a forward position early, followed the leaders four wide, gained a slight edge in the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. SHYTOE LAFEET, within striking distance and between foes three or four wide, continued near the inside into the lane, split foes into the final furlong and managed a mild gain. KEYS raced four or five wide most of the way and offered a mild late gain. ON A CLOUD, outrun while saving ground to the lane, eased out thee wide but lacked a closing account. ROYAL PLEASURE tracked the pace four or five wide to the upper stretch and flattened out. LEGISLADY weakened nearing the stretch. JILL INDY PULPIT bobbed at the start and never was prominent. RADIANT AVIE sprinted clear soon after the start, made the pace until the head of the lane and gave way.
