CLOSE ALLY close up from the start, moved up off the rail after a half, challenged on the second turn and drew off under steady urging. COZY KITTEN closest to the pace, saved ground on the second turn, angled out for the drive and lodged a mild bid to be up for the place. TWOJOHNSANAJACK resented restraint on the first turn, moved closer between rivals on the second turn, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. PLAINVIEW unhurried early, made a run four wide out of the second turn but had no late bid. FORUM set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. WASHINGTON'S RULES within striking distance three wide, tired.
