LADY DIVA GA GA set the pace inside, responded willingly when headed by the runner up approaching the furlong marker and drew off late under steady urging. ONE TOO MANY pressed the pace off the inside, made a run at the winner once in the stretch, gained a short lead approaching the furlong marker, could not cope with LADY DIVA GA GA in the final furlong but held on to be second best. HOLIDAY BROAD reserved early, raced in the three path on the turn, angled out once in the stretch but lacked a rally. CATCHING REYS forwardly placed while off the inside and between rivals, tired in the drive. QUICK SILVER SONG close up along the inside, gave way in the drive. WINTER'S CHILD within striking distance along the inside, faded. AUDINGTON prominent early in the three path, stopped.
