METANOIA ducked in slightly at the start, settled inside, was patiently ridden in order to avoid the loose horse, swung out five wide entering the stretch and drove clear the final furlong. GRAND PRIX, within striking distance and saving ground throughout, remained along the inside for the drive, loomed boldly in the last eighth but failed to match strides with her stablemate late. GULLEY gained a slight edge early from the outside, lost the advantage to LEITH LAKE on the turn, fell back and dug in through the late stages for her position. ARIELA saved ground from early on, ranged into contention the final furlong but lacked a further response. LEITH LAKE contested the pace from early on, gained the advantage on the turn, held on well until the furlong grounds and weakened. COME ON LOUISE wasn't a factor. MISS NIKNAR raced forwardly into the upper stretch and faltered. INEZ GIRL was outrun. MOCKINGBIRD VALLEY was finished early. LESLIE'S JET reared slightly a split second before the break with the rider coming off in the gate. The stewards posted the inquiry sign involving LESLIE'S JET at the start and the final result was allowed to stand.
