LU RAVI vied for the lead under confident handling, gained the inside on the backstretch, took over when ready after six furlongs and drew clear under a mild hand ride. PANTUFLA pressed the pace outside the winner, was no match for that one while best of the others. BIOGIO'S ROSE, within striking distance, moved between rivals entering the second turn, angled to the inside soon after but had no late bid. CRAFTY OAK, unhurried early, raced out in the strip on the backstretch and had nothing left in the drive. ENDOWMENT, forwardly placed early inside, moved off the inside on the second turn and tired. BAREFOOT DYANA prompted the early pace inside, was angled out to race in the three path on the backstretch and tired.
