CITY FAIR drifted out a bit at the start, was straightened to gain the lead, edged in a bit, lost the advantage to PINE FOR ME in the upper stretch, then came again through the late stage to prevail under strong handling. PINE FOR ME followed the leaders four wide from early on, moved to the fore about the three-sixteenths pole, drifted out for several strides about the sixteenth pole and couldn't contain CITY FAIR thereafter. THE HESS EXPRESS ducked out at the start and soundly bumped SAMS TUNE, saved ground in a striking position for a half, came out seven wide for the drive, loomed a solid threat into the final furlong but failed to respond. SAMS TUNE went to her knees at the start, was slammed soon after from both sides, saved ground but lacked a closing response. GIVE PRAISE went up early to press pacesetting CITY FAIR from the outside, held on well for a half and weakened gradually. GILDED BEAUTY, six wide on the backstretch, was put to a drive at the three-eighths pole but failed to respond. DOE NA WANE was outrun while saving ground. PIONJEWEL ducked in at the break bumping soundly with SAMS TUNE, tracked the leaders four or five wide and tired leaving the turn.
