WESTERN SUMMER gained a position in behind the leaders early, moved up between foes on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, took over, was briefly clear between calls, then, while drifting out late under left-handed whipping and brushing with NORTHERN FANTASY, gamely held that one safe. NORTHERN FANTASY edged in on the backstretch, moved closer while four wide on the second turn, came out further on the course to secure room when straightened for the drive, loomed boldly outside the winner, then hung while brushed nearing the wire by WESTERN SUMMER when that one came out. TEMPTATION BOUND, within striking distance and saving ground until the stretch, came out four wide for the drive but lacked a serious late response. CHIEF'S HOGAN followed the leaders in a contending position four or five wide but failed to fire when the test came. UNION MILLS hopped at the start to trail, moved out seven or eight wide on the backstretch, continued off the inside and wasn't a threat while improving position. BOLT contested the pace inside early, raced in behind front-running WILDERNESS CAT, continued prominently until the stretch and weakened. WILDERNESS CAT went up to contest the pace early, leaned in approaching the first turn tightening it up on ARMADA, managed a narrow advantage until the stretch and tired. ARMADA, steadied sharply nearing the first turn when WILDERNESS CAT leaned in, recovered to race five wide in a contending position until nearing the stretch and tired. GUN HILL saved ground but tired.
