WISEMAN'S FERRY gained the lead soon after the start, worked his way inward nearing the first turn, went along under careful handling, opened a clear advantage entering the stretch while coming well off the inside, then increased the margin under hand urging. SARAVA, reserved early and three wide until approaching the stretch, angled five wide for the drive, wasn't a threat to the winner but easily bested the others. QUEST, in closest attendance to the winner much of the way while three abreast, was put to a drive entering the second turn, remained second into the stretch and weakened. QUEST STAR, lightly rated early while maneuvered in behind rivals, raced near the inside most of the way, then couldn't threaten while improving position. ICANSEECLEARLYNOW, inside from the start, was checked repeatedly along the rail around the first turn while in behind the winner, eased out on the backstretch to race three wide, continued prominently for six furlongs and couldn't keep pace. CONTESTED, outrun early, raced four wide much of the way and failed to menace. ROBE tracked the leaders four or five wide for six furlongs and faded. FORUM BELLS, checked when in a bit tight quarters soon after the start, never menaced.
