Footnotes

ORIENTATE sprinted clear soon after the break, raced near the inside, accomplished rapid fractions, made the balance of the pace and, after the rider peeked back leaving the furlong grounds, held sway under hand urging. ALDEBARAN, checked after the start when squeezed back, raced seven wide on the backstretch, edged in around the turn, came out to make a run from between foes nearing the final quarter, exchanged bumps with TWILIGHT ROAD when straightened into the stretch, then continued with good courage as second best. TWILIGHT ROAD, within easy striking distance while racing near the inside until approaching the stretch, came out four or five wide for the drive, leaned in and exchanged bumps with ALDEBARAN, then lacked a final response. D'WILDCAT chased the winner from early on while three or four wide, was put to a full drive at the five-sixteenths pole, then flattened out the last eighth. BINTHEBEST, a bit sluggish to start, was bumped soundly after breaking and forced out by DANCING MISSILE, raced five or six wide most of the way and was outrun. RED'S HONOR hopped a bit at the start and was bumped soon after by DANCING MISSILE, edged in to track the leaders four wide for a half and gradually weakened thereafter. DANCING MISSILE bore out badly at the start, bumped BINTHEBEST and continued out on RED'S HONOR, was checked, rushed up five wide, gave way upon going a half and was eased in the final furlong when hopelessly beaten.
