Footnotes

BELLA BIANCA, bumped at the start by SPARKLING HUMOR when that one leaned in, was a bit rank early while racing in behind the leaders, eased out four wide nearing the final quarter, angled to the rail about the three-sixteenths pole, gained the advantage approaching the final furlong and widened under mild hand urging. GRANNY'S PRIDE, never far back, made a bold run four or five wide nearing the stretch, gained about even terms when straightened for the drive but couldn't match strides with the winner late. NAVAJO BREEZE, outrun to the stretch and three or four wide, angled out from between foes leaving the turn, came wider to be eight abreast soon after and was up for third position while unable to menace the top two. BOOT STRAP gained the lead at the start, raced off the inside, battled with LISA'S GOLD, gained a slight edge on the turn, then weakened in the drive. SUPERFLY GIRL, five or six wide much of the way, was empty in the drive. WHAT TO WEAR, five wide, raced in contention to the stretch and tired. SPARKLING HUMOR leaned in at the start bumping the winner and tired approaching the stretch. LISA'S GOLD went up inside to vie for the lead early, gained a slight edge, held on well until the stretch while dueling with BOOT STRAP and tired. SATIN SONG was outrun.
