**Footnotes**

LUCIFER'S STONE, taken in hand soon after the start while racing near the inside, worked her way out five or six wide approaching the far turn, caught front-running WESTERN RANSOM in deep stretch, leaned in and exchanged bumps with that one and was along in time after the rider dropped his whip about 20 yards from the wire. WESTERN RANSOM, always well placed while following the leaders five wide under light restraint, swept to the fore in the upper stretch, opened a clear advantage, then failed to contain the winner's surge after coming out and exchanging bumps for a stride in the final sixteenth. HONEY RYDER angled in four wide early while unhurried, advanced five wide on the far turn, lost a bit of position at the furlong grounds, then dug in to earn third money while unable to challenge the top two. LAST WALTZ, nicely placed between horses four or five wide to the stretch, lacked a closing response. REALLY AMERICAN, outrun for a half and taken out seven wide on the backstretch, dropped in behind horses on the far turn, moved up between them nearing the stretch to be five wide, worked her way to the inside after being checked for a stride leaving the furlong grounds and was empty late. GALLOPING GAL, five or six wide throughout, failed to rally. MOCHA QUEEN gained the lead early, edged clear while maneuvering in three wide, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. OBLIVIOUS forwardly placed inside from early on, continued near the inside in a striking position to the stretch and came up empty. MY VINTAGE PORT moved up at once to press front-running MOCHA QUEEN three or four wide, remained close up until the end of the backstretch, tired and was taken widest entering the stretch..
