Footnotes

DREAM TIME stalked the pace from early on while four wide, moved to challenge from that position on the track in the upper stretch, reached the front about the sixteenth pole and was ridden hard the remainder. ALY'S RITA, close up from early on, raced three or four wide while pressing front-running FUTURE SAINT, reached the front a quarter-mile out, failed to hold the winner safe and hopped a shadow on the track just past the wire. STEAL THE SHOW exchanged bumps with PASSAGEWAY just after the start, reached contention leaving the turn, angled five wide into the lane but failed to gain in the final furlong. SACRED FEATHER, outrun to the stretch, rallied four or five wide to reach contention at the furlong grounds but failed to offer a further account. SEEINSBELIEVEN hopped at the break and swerved out, was checked to trail, was outrun to the stretch and not a threat while passing tired horses. FUTURE SAINT gained the lead early, edged clear while maneuvering inside, lost the edge to ALY'S RITA a quarter-mile out and tired. PASSAGEWAY exchanged bumps with STEAL THE SHOW after the break and weakened approaching the stretch. ISLE SEE YOU LATER tired upon going a half. MISS DIAMONDLEGS weakened midway on the turn.
