

Footnotes

IN THE GOLD, unhurried early and confidently ridden throughout, raced four wide, advanced steadily four wide on the turn, came a bit wider entering the stretch, battled with ASPEN TREE while outside that one into the final furlong and drove clear under intermittent urging. ASPEN TREE drifted out at the break, was a bit rank during the opening furlong while two or three wide and racing in behind BROOKE'S HALO, rallied from the rail entering the lane, gained a slight edge, battled with the winner while inside that one into the final furlong and couldn't keep pace as second best. HOT STORM stumbled lightly at the start when the ground appeared to break from beneath her, was never far back, stalked the pace four wide, moved with the winner while just inside IN THE GOLD entering the stretch but flattened out in the drive. PUNCH APPEAL bobbed at the break, was lightly checked, went up quickly to press the issue four wide, inched to the front entering the turn, continued close up until the final quarter and faltered in the drive. BROOKE'S HALO, forced out a bit after the start by ASPEN TREE, moved to the fore soon after while near the inside, lost the advantage to PUNCH APPEAL entering the turn, was put to an all out drive before going a half, gave way readily approaching the stretch and was eased up leaving the furlong pole.
