### Footnotes

NIGHT PARTY tracked the pace along the inside, shifted out leaving the turn, jammed between horses entering the stretch, got through and quickly drew clear. SENOR DEHERE (AUS) settled saving ground, angled out and split horses entering the stretch, finished well and clearly proved second best. GOODTIMEHADBYALL was unhurried into stride, circled the field eight wide and was along for the show. SHRILL contested the pace three wide, but weakened in the final furlong and gave way. ENCLOSURE veered in at the start and was slow into stride, was rank to place and tugged his was forward, offered his bid four wide but failed to sustain the drive. KEEP ME POSTED was allowed to settle, came five wide and finished with a mild rally. GUTSY CALL disputed the pace between horses, then along the inside, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. POWHATAN COUNTY showed little. STORMY SPIRIT contended off of the inside for a half and dropped out.
