Footnotes

CHEROKEE PATH drifted in at the start while gaining the lead, battled with GAFF early, put him away entering the stretch and was kept to his task. KILLENAULE, never far back while four or five wide, moved five abreast into the final furlong and slowly was gaining in the late stages. GALLANT GOLD, sluggish to start and forced in slightly by the winner, was outsprinted to the lane, angled six or seven wide for the drive and offered steady gain. SWISSLE STICK tracked the dueling leaders three or four wide to the stretch, remained prominent four wide into the final furlong and flattened out. KELLY G'S CAT, within striking distance while racing near the inside throughout, was empty when the test came. DIXIE SLEW, five or six wide most of the way, failed to rally. GAFF angled in early to press the winner three or four wide, raced close up to the stretch and tired. HALF PINT BOXER, four or five wide throughout, never reached serious contention. SECRET STRANGER was outrun. BUZZISA NINER, six wide throughout, never menaced.
