Footnotes

CHARGING INDIAN, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, swept to the front in the upper stretch and drove clear under strong handling. YES YES YES, forwardly placed from the outset, moved up between foes leaving the turn, gained even terms for the lead while tightening it up on ON THE PROWL, then wasn't a match for the winner late. WAR TEMPO drifted in after the start, was outprinted early, remained inside entering the lane, angled out six wide at the eighth pole and bested the others. TIME OUT, outrun to the stretch, maneuvered six wide into the lane and improved position. SUMMER MAN, outrun for a half, improved position while not a threat. KING LION, well placed four or five wide, moved with the winner on the turn, angled outside that one when straightened for the drive and weakened. HEDGE YOUR BET, outrun early and seven wide on the backstretch, trailed to the lane, came out four wide for the drive and improved position. HOLD THE SALT tired after three furlongs. CARNIVAL SHOW battled for the lead inside from early on, gained a slight edge while dueling with ON THE PROWL on the turn but faltered in the drive. ON THE PROWL swerved out while breaking awkwardly, raced eight wide early, edged in four wide concluding the backstretch to duel for the lead, gained a slight edge, lost it to CARNIVAL SHOW from the inside on the turn, held on well for a half, was forced to steady and squeezed back in tight leaving the quarter-mile ground, then gave way readily thereafter.
