Footnotes

ARTIE SCHILLER, well placed from the outset while rated near the inside between horses, eased out four wide to secure room approaching the stretch, inched to the front in the upper stretch, then was going under solid left-handed urging in the drive. GULCH APPROVAL hopped slightly at the start, bobbed a bit when landing, quickly recovered to press front-running TRADE FAIR (GB) in hand four wide, inched to the front just before going a half, managed a slight edge into the stretch, lost the lead to the winner, then continued on with good courage to save the place. GOOD REWARD, never far back, saved ground into the backstretch, eased out between foes three or four wide, briefly lacked room leaving the quarter-mile ground behind the leaders, worked his way outside the winner five wide and couldn't muster the needed response. MR. LIGHT (ARG), close up early, was steadied sharply entering the first turn behind TRADE FAIR (GB) when that one came in slightly, quickly recovered, raced in a challenging position four wide to the stretch and was empty when straightened for the drive. TRADE FAIR (GB) maneuvered near the inside nearing the first turn while gaining the lead, was headed midway on the backstretch from the outside by GULCH APPROVAL, continued forwardly to the stretch and weakened. COOL CONDUCTOR broke awkwardly, settled in behind horses while outrun, worked his way out five or six wide for the drive and improved position. SALFORD CITY (IRE), unhurried early and five wide, came out eight or nine wide for the drive but lacked a late response. MUQBIL, bumped after breaking sluggishly by B. A. WAY, failed to rally. LAURA'S LUCKY BOY, four or five wide early, made a mild run between calls on the far turn after angling in between foes but was empty when straightened into the stretch. B. A. WAY leaned in at the start bumping MUGBIL, raced within easy striking distance five wide for six furlongs and faltered.
