STAKES Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each, which should accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 added and an additional \$100,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup eligibles only. Keeneland Association added monies and all fees to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weights: Three year olds, 116 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since October 29 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade I or II stakes since September 5, 4 lbs.; \$45,000 twice since July 4, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing Wednesday April 12, 2006. A Breeders' Cup trophy and gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, April 5, 2006 with 24 nominations.

Footnotes

SUN KING bumped at the start, was outrun early, waited behind rivals around the turn, angled out in upper stretch and closed fast to win going away. KAZOO vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear into the stretch but faltered late. SPANISH CHESTNUT stumbled at the start, rushed to force the pace off the inside, dropped back a bit into the stretch then went evenly in the final furlong. SAINTLY LOOK angled in early when outsprinted, raced in the two path on the turn, angled out in upper stretch but lacked the needed closing bid. FIFTEEN ROUNDS drifted in after the start, angled in when reserved, raced near the rail on the turn and had no late bid. VICARAGE close up along the inside, held on well to mid stretch and tired. COUGAR CAT well back early, raced in the three path and improved his position while no threat. CRAFTY SCHEMER forwardly placed between rivals, gave way in the drive. MISTER FOTIS five wide into the turn, could not menace. WILD TALE as outrun. STRAIGHT LINE within striking distance, raced four wide into the turn and faded

after a half. KELLY'S LANDING prominent three wide, gave way.
